Your Beaver Dry-Flex Gloves have been designed to protect your hands from harsh cold water conditions and allow a firm grip. They are manufactured from 'Superstretch' neoprene which provides fantastic flexibility and comfort. Beaver Dry-Flex Gloves also feature a dry seal around the cuffs to minimise water ingress, adding additional protection for your hands in cold waters. These Beaver Dry-Flex Gloves have been manufactured to stringent quality control regulations, giving you a product which is strong, durable and will give years of trouble-free service provided a few basic instructions are adhered to.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Always ensure that the equipment you purchase is a suitable size and fit for the application for which it is intended, gloves should be a tight fit, but not uncomfortable. If you are not sure seek the advice of an authorised Beaver dealer.
2. Prior to use, ensure that your gloves are in good condition and free from faults or damage that may impair their proper and safe use. Check all the seals, seams and material for holes or tears. Never use faulty or damaged equipment.
3. Avoid damage to the glove seal sections with your finger nails or other sharp objects. After use roll the outer material back to the normal position. Do not pull the finger tips or on the seal sections as this will distort and damage your gloves.
4. To wear, gently slide your hand into the gloves, carefully roll the outer seal section and place your suit wrist over the inner seal section. Carefully roll the outer seal section back and place over your suit wrist ensuring an even and firm seal is achieved.
5. To remove, carefully roll the outer seal section and carefully pull back your suit wrist. Remove gloves from your hands by gently easing your palm out of the gloves.
6. After use, thoroughly rinse in fresh water. Avoid contact with solvents, detergents, oils, etc. To clean your gloves and any other neoprene products such as your wetsuit, hood and boots use McNett Wet Suit Shampoo available from all Beaver stockists.
7. To store your gloves always ensure they are completely dry, kept away from heat sources and direct exposure to the sun.
