SPECIFICATIONS

All Beaver compasses are CE marked, and manufactured to comply with EN 250.
May be read up to 15° from horizontal.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

1. Ensure that the compass is suitable for the application for which it is to be used. Seek the expert advice of an authorised Beaver dealer.
2. A wrist mounted compass should be securely fastened to your wrist. Pull the strap to the desired length and fasten using the buckle. The strap may be shortened if desired, so the compass can be clearly seen.
3. A hose mounted compass should be securely attached to a suitable hose. Carefully unscrew the hose attachment on the rear until the attachment comes apart. Place the threaded section either side of the hose and re-assemble.
4. Never fasten any items in a position that may obstruct or hinder the safe operation of other equipment, interfere with other persons or cause damage to the underwater environment. If in any doubt, consult your Beaver dealer.
5. Do not dive below a depth of 50 metres.
6. Keep away from heat sources and avoid direct exposure to the sun.
7. Do not use the compass if in close proximity of metals or magnetic forces.
8. After use rinse in fresh water and avoid contact with solvents, detergents, oils, etc.
