INSTRUCTIONS

1. Ensure that the hood you purchase and use is suitable for the application intended. Beaver offer a comprehensive range of hoods of different thicknesses to suit varying temperatures of water, each of which are made from different materials to suit a wide range of applications. If you are unsure please seek the advice of an authorised Beaver dealer.
2. Ensure the hood you have chosen is a correct fit, a correctly fitting hood should be tight but not restrictive or uncomfortable.
3. Prior to use, check that the hood is in good condition and inspect the seams and material for holes or tears. Do not use damaged or faulty equipment.
4. The Beaver Pirate Hoods can be fitted before putting on your suit. To wear, carefully pull the hood evenly over your head so that your face comes out of the hood opening. Ensure an even seal is created around your face. Next place on your suit according to the suit instructions and place the long yoke section of the hood is beneath your suit seal.
5. To remove, carefully ease the hood away from your head. The hood can be removed after suit removal to avoid any damage.
6. After use, thoroughly rinse in fresh water. Avoid contact with solvents, detergents, oils, etc. To clean your hood and any other neoprene products such as your wetsuit, gloves and boots use McNett Wet Suit Shampoo available from all Beaver stockists.
7. To store your hood, always ensure it is completely dry, keep away from heat sources and direct exposure to the sun.
