## **HIGH PRESSURE BRAIDED HOSE**

This Beaver High Pressure Braided Hose is an integral part of your life support system and should be treated with as much care as the rest of your equipment. This Hose has been manufactured to stringent quality control regulations, giving you a product which is strong, durable and will give years of trouble-free service. It is important that this hose is fitted correctly and a few basic instructions are adhered to, failure to do so may invalidate any warranty.

## **INSTRUCTIONS**

1. Always ensure that the High Pressure Hose you purchase is suitable for the application for which it is intended. It is important that the correct type of Swivel Pin is used to suit the High Pressure Hose and relevant Cylinder Contents Gauge. It is fitted with Standard 7/16" UNF Threads on both Male & Female Ends.
2. This High Pressure Braided Hose must be fitted by an authorised service technician. If you are not sure seek the advice of an authorised Beaver Dealer.
3. Prior to diving, check that your High Pressure Hose is securely fitted and is not leaking or damaged. Under no circumstances must you dive with damaged or faulty equipment.
4. To avoid damage to your High Pressure Hose do not bend to a diameter of less than 5 cm.
5. Do not exceed the maximum working pressure of this High Pressure Hose. After use rinse in fresh water. Avoid contact with solvents, detergents, oils, etc. Keep away from heat sources, and avoid direct exposure to the sun.
6. A full range of replacement o-rings, silicone grease and hose attachments is available from all Beaver Dealers.
7. Ensure High Pressure Hoses and all diving equipment is serviced on a regular basis by an authorised technician.
8. All Beaver hoses are manufactured to comply with EN 250.
