CARE AND MAINTENANCE

1. Always ensure that the Beaver Diving Knife purchased is suitable for the application for which it is intended, if you are not sure seek the advice of an authorised Beaver dealer.
2. Ensure you are correctly trained in the use and safety of this product.
3. Under no circumstances must you dive with damaged or faulty equipment.
4. Always use caution when handling this Beaver Diving Knife.
5. Always keep this Beaver Diving Knife in its sheath when not in use.
6. Attach your Beaver Diving Knife securely, using the straps provided.
7. Ensure that your Beaver Diving Knife is fixed in a position which will enable safe and easy access and will not interfere with other equipment, persons or cause damage to the underwater environment.
8. Beaver accept no responsibility for any items lost or damaged whatever the circumstances.
9. After use, rinse your Beaver Diving Knife in fresh water, dry completely and rub a small amount of oil onto the blade before storing, taking care to avoid injury on sharp edges.
10. Spare straps, holsters, etc. are available from all Beaver dealers.
11. Due to the nature of the product, this Beaver Diving Knife must only be sold to and used by qualified and certified divers.
12. Remember that knives are potentially dangerous weapons and must only be used for their intended purpose.
13. Always ensure that your Beaver Diving Knife is stored in its sheath, in a secure and safe location and cannot be accessed by any unauthorized persons.
14. Always check and adhere to any local or national laws pertaining to the sale, storage and use of this product.
