INSTRUCTIONS

1. Always ensure that the equipment you purchase is suitable for the application for which it is intended, if you are not sure seek the advice of an authorised Beaver Dealer.
2. Prior to use, ensure that your equipment is in good condition and free from faults or damage that may impair it's proper use. Under no circumstances must you dive with damaged or faulty equipment.
3. Prior to diving, if you are using a Wrist Mounted Dive Slate, check that your Dive Slate is securely fitted to your wrist using the strap and elastic cords provided, otherwise ensure that your slate is securely fastened to your Harness or BCD in such a way as to not snag or interfere with the safe operation of on any other equipment. Also check that your Dive Slate Pencil is sharpened.
4. To avoid damage to your Dive Slate, do not bend or subject to heavy impact.
5. Do not use any marking device other than approved Beaver Underwater Dive Slate Pencils, which are available from your Beaver Dealer.
6. After use rinse in fresh water and clean with McNett Sea Buff, available from Beaver Dealers. Avoid contact with other chemical cleaners such as thinners, toluene and oils, as this will damage the surface of your Dive Slate.
7. Keep away from heat sources, and avoid direct exposure to the sun.
8. After use, rinse in fresh water and clean with McNett Sea Buff, available from all Beaver Dealers.
9. Keep away from heat sources, and avoid direct exposure to the sun.
