INSTRUCTIONS

1. A snorkel is designed to give a constant air supply while swimming on the surface. The top of the snorkel must stay above the surface while breathing.
2. Attach your snorkel to your mask, using the clip provided. Ensure that it is fixed in a position which will be comfortable when in use.
3. Water may enter the snorkel while diving below the surface, due to waves or bending your head too far back. When this occurs, exhale sharply to expel water. Certain models have a purge valve which will release most of the water when above the surface.
4. You must be a competent swimmer before snorkelling. Never snorkel alone, or in strong currents or high waves. Practice in a pool or shallow water.
5. After use, rinse in fresh water. Avoid contact with solvents, detergents, oils, etc.
6. Spare mouthpieces, purge valves, retaining clips, etc. should be available from all good dive stores.
