This Beaver Cylinder Net is an integral part of your diving equipment and should be treated with as much care as the rest of your accessories. The purpose of your Beaver Cylinder Net is to protect your cylinder against accidental damage and abrasions. Beaver Cylinder Nets are been manufactured from materials specially designed for use in and around the water and has been manufactured to stringent quality control regulations, giving you a product which is strong, durable and will give years of trouble-free service provided a few basic instructions are adhered to.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Ensure you have the correct sized Beaver Cylinder Net for your cylinder, if you are unsure, consult your local Beaver Dealer for guidance.
2. For safety reasons your cylinder must be completely empty of any air pressure before fitting your Beaver Cylinder Net.
3. Remove the cylinder from your B.C.D. or harness as per the manufacturer's instructions and then remove the boot from the cylinder.
4. Carefully Lay the cylinder flat on a suitable flat surface. Ensure that the drawstring is loose at both ends of the Cylinder Net, pull the Cylinder Net and carefully ease the Cylinder in to the Cylinder Net and steadily pull one end of the Cylinder Net up the entire length of the cylinder.
5. Securely pull and tie the lower drawstring in the centre of the cylinder base, ensure that the Cylinder Net is neatly aligned along the full length of the cylinder and pull and tie the drawstring around the neck of the cylinder.
6. Your Beaver Cylinder Net is now fitted and ready for re-assembly with your cylinder boot and attachment back on to your jacket or harness system as per the manufacturer's instructions.
7. Rinse in fresh water after use and store in a cool dry location after ensuring that the Cylinder Net is dry, keep away from heat sources and direct sunlight.
