COMMANDER FINS

These Beaver Commander Fins are an integral part of your diving equipment and should be treated with as much care as the rest of your accessories. Your Commander Fins have been designed for use for Scuba diving or Snorkelling and have been manufactured from materials specially designed for use in and around the water. This pair of Commander Fins has been manufactured to stringent quality control regulations, giving you a product which is strong, durable and will give years of trouble-free service provided a few basic instructions are adhered to.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Ensure that Commander Fins are the correct type for the application intended, Commander Fins are designed for use with neoprene or integral dry-suit boots. Ensure that you obtain the correct size, seek the expert advice of your Beaver Dealer for assistance.
2. Prior to diving, check that strap and attachments work correctly, and inspect the blades and foot pockets for cracks or tears. Do not dive with damaged or faulty equipment.
3. To avoid damage to the spring straps and attachments, do not stretch excessively.
4. Spare spring straps are available from all Beaver dealers. It is recommended that these are carried on diving trips should the need arise.
5. To wear, carefully pull the loop to extend the spring strap. Carefully insert your boot and fix the loop section of the spring strap over your boot fin retainer to provide a comfortable, firm and stable fitting.
6. To remove your Commander Fins, carefully pull the loop of the spring strap back and place under the sole of your boots, carefully withdraw your feet from the fins.
7. After use rinse in fresh water. Avoid contact with solvents, detergents, oils, etc.
8. Keep away from heat sources, and avoid prolonged exposure to the sun.
9. To extend the life of rubber components, apply McNett Seal Saver, available from all Beaver dealers.
